ABOUT THE WORKSHOP: In this exciting workshop, students will learn to broaden their imagination through the use of techniques, materials, and color while creating works in abstraction. Focus will be on the elements of texture, shape, value, color, and the principles of design.

INSTRUCTOR: Alton Coleman is a native Georgian and contemporary artist who resides in the Atlanta metro area. Alton's work has been on display at such venues as The Mable House (Mableton, GA), the Marietta Cobb Museum of Art (Marietta, GA), the Mellwood Art Center (Louisville, KY), and Gallery 4463 (Acworth, GA). His colorful works of art come in the form of acrylics, mixed-media, and found-object collages. He believes that:
