**ABOUT THE WORKSHOP:** Any level of artist will be comfortable in this class where the emphasis will be on the painting of water and the blending of oil paints to attain the colors you are looking for. With numerous demonstrations and a hands-on approach, Artist Barry Nehr will equip students with the skills needed, and the confidence to add water to their landscapes.

**INSTRUCTOR:** Barry Nehr was born and raised in Lancaster Pennsylvania. For 20 years he was the Regional Illustrator for the U.S. Forest Service in Atlanta.

Barry's paintings are available in numerous galleries around the Southeast. He has painted murals for several exhibit companies that can be seen all across the United States, including Sea World California, Warner Robbins Air Force Base in Georgia, as well as many State and National Parks.

Barry primarily works in oils. He describes his painting style as impressionistic, with an emphasis on color, light, and shadow. He is also skilled in the use of pen and ink and felt markers, which he uses to produce illustrations for many educational exhibits.
