The arrangement of our outdoor festival setup will be similar to last year. The Native American Village will be to the north side of the western stage and the Western Market Place will be in the same general area as last year. Art Under The Oaks will be in the same area but spread out more to make it easier to navigate. According to the majority of surveys returned, this was a successful setup using separate interest pods:

Western Cowboy Marketplace: Vintage clothing, saddles, leather carving, leather belts, old time photos, metal-works, western furniture. We are merging the Pioneer setup into this area with pottery being made lye soap making, basket weaving, chair caning, primitive antiques and many other items.

Native American Indian Village: For Native American items such as, jewelry, blankets, beading, baskets, bow and arrows, etc

Art Under the Oaks: for our artsy folks that just don't fit into a certain category, paintings, sculpture, painted gourds, carvings, etc. Artists feel free to bring your supplies and show us how your masterpieces are created.

Each demonstrator will choose the category where they and their wares will best fit in. Our research shows this concept has been used successfully in many different events across the country, drawing many people with matching interests into the areas for the vendors. Thank you to all who gave us feedback on this setup last year.

We will assign spaces as we receive your reservation. **Application and payment is due no later than August 30, 2016, or we will have to reassign your space to the next one on our waiting list**.
