

A Garden of Greatness:

Students will create Presidential Flowers

Materials:

white and colored construction paper, colored pencils, glue, scissors

Directions:

1. Cut out one white circle to be the center of your flower. Cut out 6 petals from the colored paper. Cut out a stem from green paper.
2. Draw a picture of a president on the white circle.
3. Write the President's name on the stem.
4. Write a fact about the President on each petal:
 - When he was born and when he died
 - Where he was born and where he lived
 - Who he married and number of children they had
 - What important thing he did as President (Choose one.)
 - Why you chose him
 - How he helped the United States
5. Glue the parts of the flower onto a colored piece of construction paper.
6. Flowers may be displayed in a Garden of Greatness.
