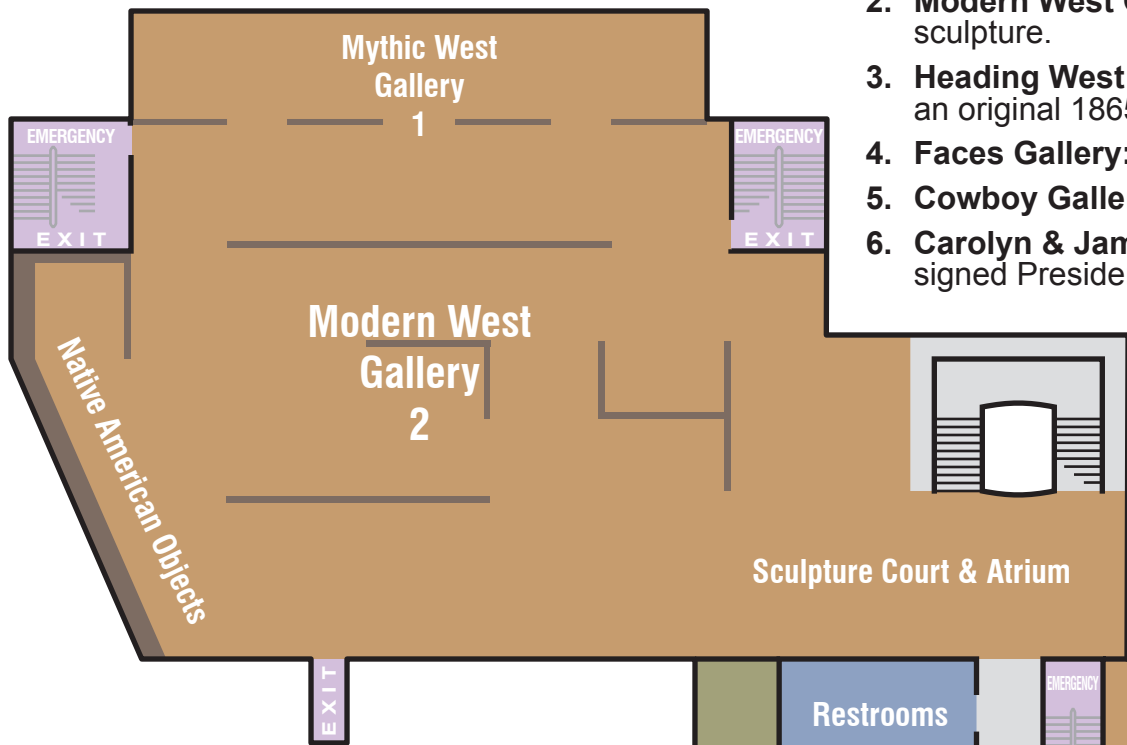
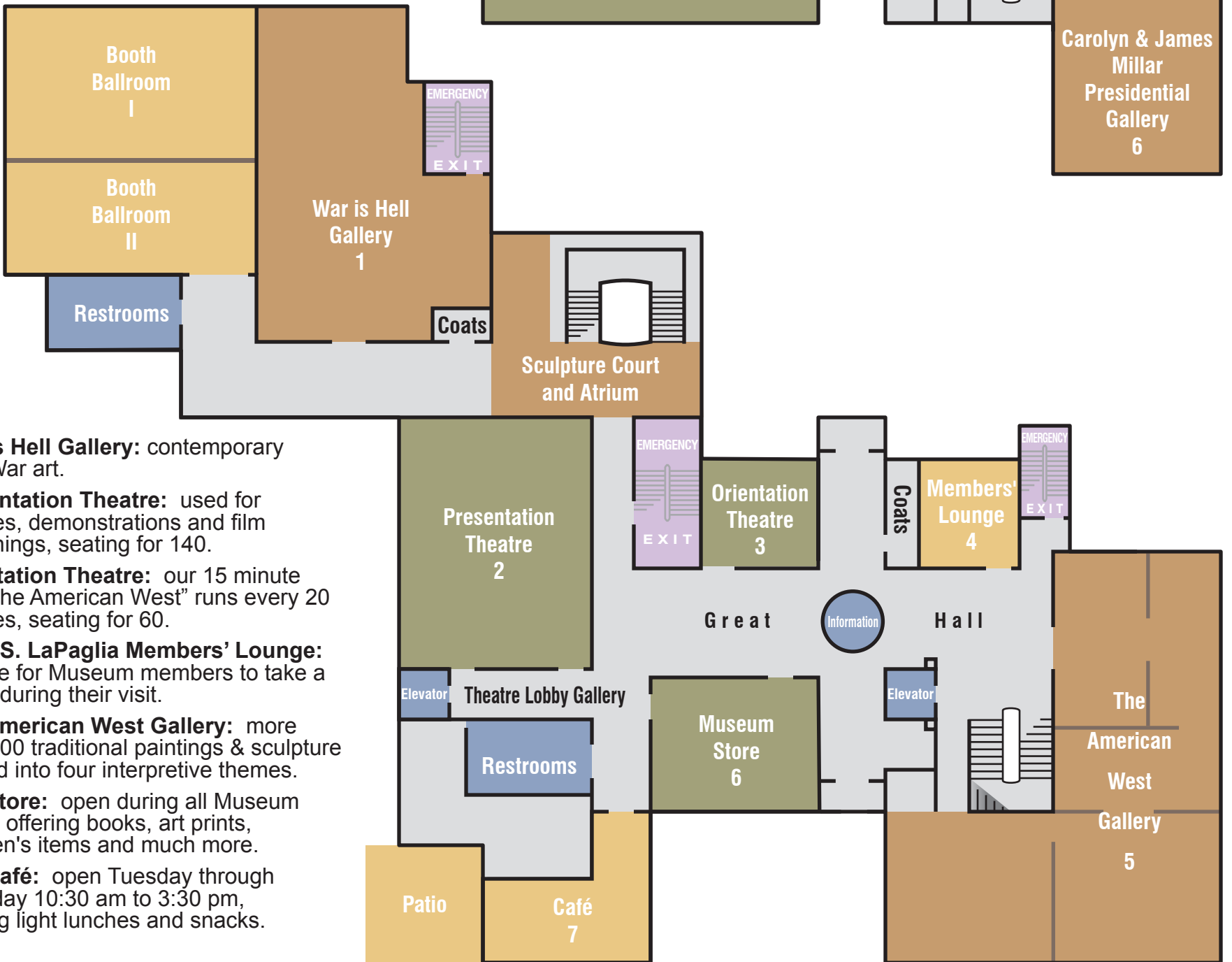


Upper Level



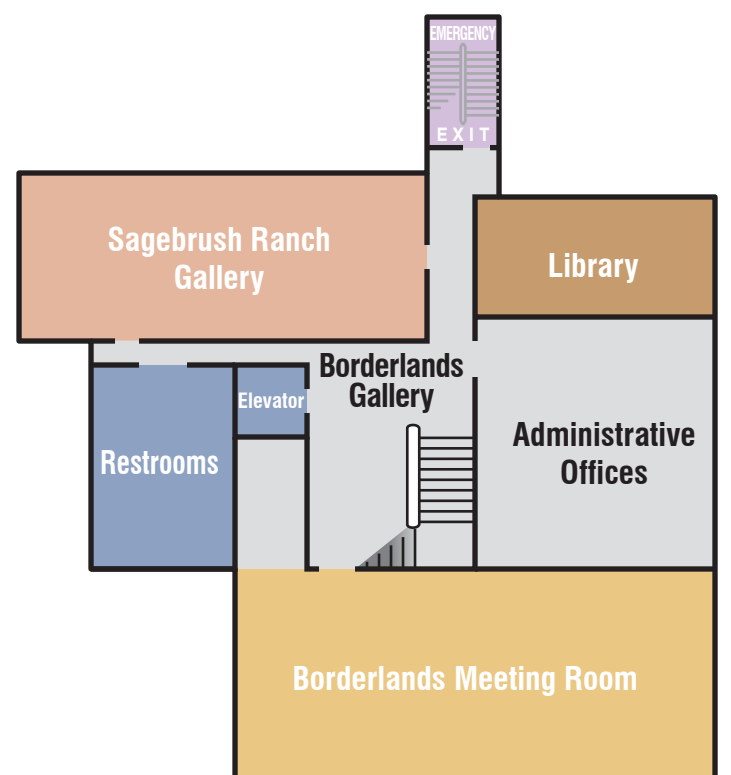
- 1. Mythic West Gallery:** Western illustration and movie posters.
- 2. Modern West Gallery:** contemporary Western paintings and sculpture.
- 3. Heading West Gallery:** depictions of Americans on the move and an original 1865 stagecoach.
- 4. Faces Gallery:** portraits of the diverse people who settled the West.
- 5. Cowboy Gallery:** artwork showing cowboys at work, rest and play.
- 6. Carolyn & James Millar Presidential Gallery:** original one-page signed Presidential letters and a photograph of each President.

Main Level



- 1. War is Hell Gallery:** contemporary Civil War art.
- 2. Presentation Theatre:** used for lectures, demonstrations and film screenings, seating for 140.
- 3. Orientation Theatre:** our 15 minute film "The American West" runs every 20 minutes, seating for 60.
- 4. Peter S. LaPaglia Members' Lounge:** a place for Museum members to take a break during their visit.
- 5. The American West Gallery:** more than 100 traditional paintings & sculpture divided into four interpretive themes.
- 6. The Store:** open during all Museum hours, offering books, art prints, children's items and much more.
- 7. The Café:** open Tuesday through Saturday 10:30 am to 3:30 pm, serving light lunches and snacks.
