Live Auction on Zoom

1. How can I participate in the Live Auction?
 - *Become a Point Rider or purchase a ticket by visiting <https://boothmuseum.org/auction/>.*
2. How do I bid in the Live Auction?
 - *Point Riders and ticket holders will receive a Party Box mailed to their home that includes a bid paddle. Simply hold your paddle in front of your webcam until the auctioneer calls your number recognizing your bid.*
3. Can I place an absentee bid?
 - *You can place an absentee bid by contacting Pam Hessenbruch at pamh@boothmuseum.org. Absentee bids must be submitted by 12:00 pm EST on Friday, February 19.*
4. How can I receive a condition report or estimated shipping charges for an item in the silent auction?
 - *Contact Lynn Tatum at lynnt@boothmuseum.org.*
5. When will my credit card be charged?
 - *A Booth Museum employee will contact you for your payment information 1 to 3 days after the auction closing. Hindman Auction will not charge your credit card. There is no buyer's premium.*
6. How will I receive my items?
 - *If you wish to pick up your auction items, please contact Lynn Tatum at lynnt@boothmuseum.org to make an appointment for pick up. Items will be available after February 24 and must be paid in full. If you need your items shipped, please discuss with the Booth employee that contacts you about payment.*
